## Course Evaluation

1. Lecture attendance and exercise attendance are mandatory. Only three\*absences are allowed in the term. If the student exceeds the allowable number of absences is going to be automatically deleted from the course with the final mark 2.0 (exercises+lectures/course).

- 2. There are two midterm tests. Each test consists of four problems.

  The value of each problem is 5 points.
- 3. Bonus points (max 6 points): additional quizzes and involvement.
- 4. Grading scale: 0-20 (2); 20.5-24 (3.0); 24.5-28 (3.5); 28.5-32 (4.0); 32.5-36 (4.5); 36.5-45 (5.0). The mark above 3.0 is a passing mark (exercises) which cannot be appealed. This is also a passing mark from the course.
- A student who gets 2.0 from exercises must write an exam (6 problems, the value of each problem is 5 points). Grading scale: 0-15
   (2); 15.5-18 (3.0); 18.5-21 (3.5); 21.5-24 (4.0); 24.5-27 (4.5); 27.5-45 34
   (5.0). (20% of points from the midterms are added to the score.)
- During the tests and exams every student should provide the proof of identity.
- 7. Cheating during tests and exams ends up with the final mark 2.0 from the whole course and cannot be appealed.
