1. (4 points) Find the complex solutions to the equation $z^{2}-2 i z-i+1=0$. The answer give in the Carthesian form.
2. (5 points) Decompose the rational function $\frac{x^{3}-1}{x^{4}-x^{2}+1}$ into irreducible real fractions.
3. (4 points) Tetrahedron $T$ has a vertex at the origin $O$ and other three vertices $P_{1}, P_{2}, P_{3}$ obtained by intersection of the lines

$$
\ell_{1}:\left\{\begin{array}{l}
x=t \\
y=-t \\
z=2 t
\end{array}, \quad \ell_{2}:\left\{\begin{array}{l}
x=-2 t \\
y=t \\
z=-t
\end{array}, \quad \ell_{3}:\left\{\begin{array}{l}
x=t \\
y=-2 t \\
z=-t
\end{array}\right.\right.\right.
$$

with the plane

$$
x+y+z=1 .
$$

Find the volume of the tetrahedron $T$.
4. (4 points) Find the inverse matrix to $\left(\begin{array}{lll}1 & -2 & 3 \\ 2 & -3 & 4 \\ 3 & -4 & 6\end{array}\right)$.
5. (4 points) Solve the system of linear equations

$$
\left\{\begin{array}{l}
x+2 y-3 z+v=1 \\
-2 x-3 y+4 z-v=2 \\
3 x+8 y-12 z+2 v=-1
\end{array} .\right.
$$

6. (5 points) Find eigenvalues and eigenvectors of the matrix $\left(\begin{array}{rrr}-1 & 2 & -1 \\ 4 & -3 & 2 \\ 12 & -6 & 5\end{array}\right)$.
